- 4. I will not be afraid to ask clarifying questions if I don't understand the session plan.
- 5. I will do my best to respond when the coach asks me a question.
- 6. I will respect and encourage all of my teammates.
- 7. If a teammate makes a mistake, I will provide positive reinforcement.

Finally, all children must help pick up the soccer balls and cones before leaving practices.

Dragons F.C. Coach's Expectations for Parents

At Practices:

If your child is misbehaving and not focusing, I would appreciate it if you could gain their attention and, in a pleasant manner, ask them to focus.

I encourage parents to pick up the balls when they leave the play area and keep track of the equipment.

I'll invite some of the parents to help with some of the drills.

In game:

You are encouraged to give your children positive reinforcement. However, any strategic or tactical decisions regarding the game should be left to the coach.

Arguing with the referee is unacceptable, and it might result in a ban from viewing games.

Arguments with the opposing team's parents and children are not permitted.

An offense can result in a ban from watching the games.

Please keep track of our balls.

PLEASE ARRIVE ON TIME FOR THE GAMES. ATLEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE GAME TIME.

IF YOU HAVE ANY CONCERNS OR FEEDBACK AFTER A GAME PLEASE WAIT ATLEAST AN HOUR TO CONTACT US.
